



“Killiecrankie Diamonds”

You will find “Killiecrankie Diamonds” at the North West End of the Island known as Killiecrankie Bay. The main collection area is among the granite boulders on the foreshore up the end of the bay known as Diamond Gully.

The area yields topaz crystals along with smoky quartz. The topaz occurs as glassy, well-formed crystals or waterworn pebbles usually colourless to pale blue but also translucent white or in pale shades of pink and yellow. Crystals up to 20mm in size are abundant and some up to 80mm have been reported.



Killiecrankie is very scenic with a beautiful beach to swim all times of the day. There is a small village situated at Killiecrankie with a great BBQ area and toilet facilities. There are also a couple of walks you can do with magnificent views.
