

## Top 10 fishing tips on Flinders Island!

- 🦞 Catch a calamari squid, flathead or trevally off the Lady Barron wharf
- 🦞 The slipway area in Lady Barron might land you a garfish during the cooler months
- 🦞 Try your luck spearing a flounder or fishing for flathead or Australian salmon at the North East River – you're bound to land one! In season you can also dip net for some fresh prawns!
- 🦞 Hook yourself a flathead off the Whitemark wharf
- 🦞 Many of the western beaches in easterly weather will also produce flathead, visit Marshall Bay, Lillies Beach and Long Point
- 🦞 Go on a boat ride and fish in the warm waters of the Continental Shelf with one of the local charter operators
- 🦞 Surf Fishing for Gummy Shark at Camerons Inlet could be a winner – especially around the full moon.
- 🦞 Salmon Rocks (Eastern end of Trousers Point beach) is a good spot to land a kingfish off the rocks if you're lucky. Also try fishing for squid off the rocks below the BBQ area
- 🦞 Max's Store at Lady Barron and Killiecrankie Enterprises in Whitemark carry a large supply of fishing tackle

If you didn't have any luck on the day ... (which is highly unlikely)

- 🦞 Order a crayfish from Killiecrankie Enterprises (in season)
- 🦞 Local 'Fish of Day' available at the Shearwater Restaurant at the Furneaux Tavern or on the menu at the Interstate Hotel
