

Top Fishing Tips on Flinders Island



- Catch a calamari squid, flathead or trevally off the Lady Barron Wharf.
- Land a garfish during the cooler months at the slipway area in Lady Barron.
- Try your luck spearing a flounder or fishing for flathead and Australian salmon at the North East River – you're bound to land one! In season, you can also dip a net for some fresh prawns!
- Hook yourself a flathead off the Whitemark wharf.
- Try the western beaches - Marshall Bay, Lillies Beach and Long Point - in easterly weather for flathead.
- Take a boat and fish in the warm waters of the Continental Shelf with one of the local charter operators.
- Surf fish for gummy shark at Camerons Inlet around the full moon.
- Land a kingfish off Salmon Rocks, (Eastern end of Trousers Point Beach).
- Try fishing for squid off the rocks below the BBQ area.
- Shop for a large supply of fishing tackle at Lady Barron Store.
- Hire Flinders Island Adventures to take you out and catch flathead, tuna or marlin.

If you didn't have any luck on the day ... (which is highly unlikely), enjoy a crayfish meal or catch of the day at one of our local restaurants.

Gas BBQ, toilets, camp ground (overnight only), picnic area, swimming

Trousers Pt Beach – Strezelecki National Park

Gas BBQ, toilets, camp ground, picnic area, swimming, snorkeling, fishing, walks, wildlife observation

Whitemark Foreshore

Gas BBQ's, toilets, picnic area, swimming, fishing and a newly installed exercise area

Effluent Disposal Facilities (Dumpezy) is located at the Whitemark Showgrounds – near stockyards, behind Trade Pavilion.
